WHAT WE ARE FOCUSING ON

BOOSTING LITERACY AND NUMERACY

- Teachers use explicit, consistent teaching methods across all classes
- Daily reviews, whiteboards and check-for-understanding used in every classroom
- Extra support for students who need help and extension for students who need challenge
- Regular coaching, mentoring and observation for teachers to strengthen practice
- Clear expectations for new and existing staff through an improved induction program
- Updated Literacy and Numeracy Playbooks aligned with the NT Learning and Teaching Model
- Building more Instructional Leaders within the school

RAISING ATTENDANCE AND HOLDING PARENTS ACCOUNTABLE

- Clear attendance expectations for all families
- Early follow-up when attendance drops, including phone calls, letters and meetings
- Attendance and Engagement Officer supporting families and teachers
- Strong partnerships with community agencies to support students
- Clear, updated roles, responsibilities and processes for staff
- Regular attendance reviews and case management for students with ongoing concerns

WHAT SUCCESS WILL LOOK LIKE

FOR STUDENTS

- Stronger reading and maths skills
- More confidence in learning
- Regular attendance and improved engagement
- Clear understanding of learning goals and routines

FOR STAFF

- Consistent teaching across the whole school
- Strong collaboration, coaching and professional growth
- Clear expectations and support systems

FOR FAMILIES

- Better understanding of classroom practices
- Stronger partnerships with the school
- Easier access to support and services

OUR TARGETS

- Improved reading and maths results across all year levels
- Fewer students needing extra support
- Strong participation in NAPLAN and Year 1 Phonics Check
- Average attendance increasing from 90% to 91% overall
- Aboriginal student attendance increasing from 83.2% to 90%
